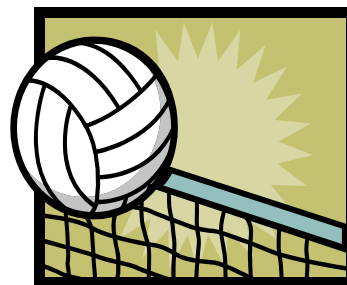
TIGERS VOLLEYBALL NEWS
