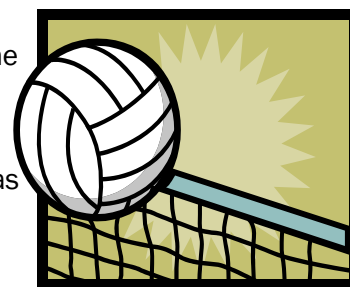
The season ended too quickly. A full recap in the next newsletter.
