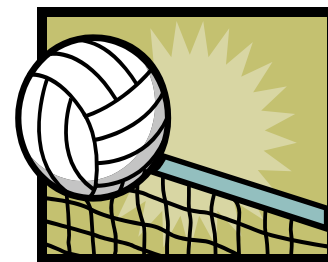
## TIGERS VOLLEYBALL NEWS
