Mandatory 6th Grade Student/Parents Meeting

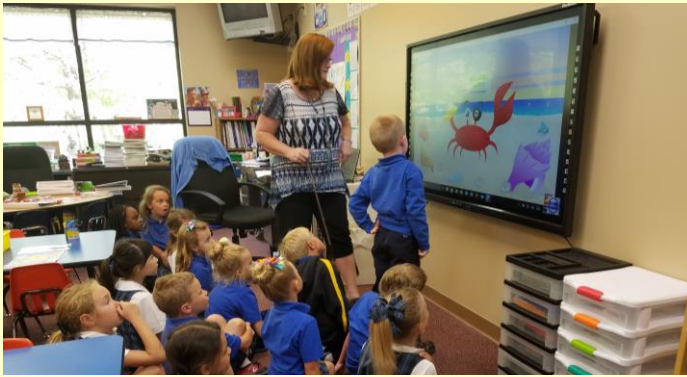
Wednesday, September 13th
