2019-2020 Registration is Open

For returning families with students in **4/5 Preschool through grade 7**, your student(s) will automatically be enrolled for the next school year per the TADS continuous enrollment agreement.

For 3/4 Preschool students, you will need to select which 4/5 Preschool option you would like to enroll in, via TADS.

April 1st - Deadline to notify us in writing if you choose not to enroll.

May 1st - Registration fees of \$200 per family (\$75 pre-K) will be billed. (Registration fee are non-refundable.)

July 1st - First tuition payment for the 2019-2020 school year will be billed.
