# **1:1 iPad Program**

## *Student Acceptable Use Policy*

The use of the Transfiguration Catholic School technology resources is a privilege, not a right. The privilege of using the technology resources provided by the school is not transferable or extendible by students to people or groups outside the school and terminates when a student is no longer enrolled in the school.

This policy is provided to make all users aware of the responsibilities associated with efficient, ethical, and lawful use of technology resources. If a person violates any of the User Terms and Conditions named in this policy, privileges may be terminated, access to the school's technology resources may be denied, and the appropriate disciplinary action shall be applied. The Transfiguration Catholic School Acceptable Use Policy shall be applied to student infractions.

**Violations may result in disciplinary action up to and including suspension/expulsion for students. When applicable, law enforcement agencies may be involved.**

### **STUDENT ACTIVITIES STRICTLY PROHIBITED:**

- Illegal installation or transmission of copyrighted materials.
- Any action that violates existing School policy or public law.
- Sending, accessing, uploading, downloading, or distributing offensive, profane, threatening, pornographic, obscene, or sexually explicit materials.
- Use of chat rooms, sites selling term papers, book reports and other forms of student work.
- Use of any Messaging services-EX: MSN Messenger, ICQ, AIM, IMO, etc.
- Non educational games. Only educational games, which in no way contradict our mission as a Catholic school may be used with permission of a teacher.

- Use of outside data disks or external attachments without prior approval from the administration.
- Changing of iPad settings (exceptions include personal settings such as font size, brightness, etc).
- "Jailbreaking" of your iPad.
- Spamming-Sending mass or inappropriate emails.
- Gaining access to other student's accounts, files, and/or data.
- Use of the school's internet/E-mail accounts for financial or commercial gain or for any illegal activity.
- Use of anonymous and/or false communications such as, but not limited to, MSN Messenger, Yahoo Messenger, email, etc.
- Participation in credit card fraud, electronic forgery or other forms of illegal behavior.
- Vandalism (any malicious attempt to harm or destroy hardware, software or data, including, but not limited to, the uploading or creation of computer viruses or computer programs that can infiltrate computer systems and/or damage software components) of school equipment will not be allowed.
- Transmission or accessing materials that are obscene, offensive, threatening or otherwise intended to harass or demean recipients.
- Bypassing the Transfiguration Catholic School web content filter through a web proxy.
- Students are not allowed to use another student's iPad.
